



Troop 853 Arts & Crafts Bazaar

EXHIBITOR TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. All Exhibitors must be set up and ready to sell by 8:00 am the day of the event. Exhibitors may begin setting up at 6:00 am the day of the event.
2. Booths must remain staffed and intact until the event closes at 4:00 pm.
3. Only one (1) business per booth space; space may not be sublet or shared without prior approval of an authorized representative of Troop 853.
4. Tractors, trailers vans and other vehicles must be parked in the designated area during event hours. No vehicles will be permitted in the show area between the hours of 8:00 am and 4:00 pm. Due to limited space we ask that all exhibitors unload their vehicle, park and then return to setup.
5. Troop 853 reserves the right to decline any application for space if it deems such action to be in the best interest of the Bazaar.
6. The full payment is a non-refundable registration fee for the booth space and is due with the submission of this agreement.
7. Booths are reserved on a first-come, first-served basis. We will work with the Exhibitor on the best placement.
8. Music within an Exhibitor's booth must be kept within a tolerable range from the front line of the booth space. Other parameters may be enforced if the audio is objectionable to adjacent Exhibitors.
9. Exhibitors must ensure that none of their display equipment extends beyond the space that they have booked; this includes any rails, stands or additional equipment.
10. Each Exhibitor is responsible for providing his or her own tents, tables, chairs, stands or canopy. Since this is an outdoor show, it is advised to bring shims or blocks of wood to level out the tables. All tents and canopies must be secured to the ground using weights in case of windy weather. Canopies, tables and chairs are available for rent from Troop 853.
11. Items for sale at the Exhibitors booth must be predominantly handmade by the exhibitor. No vendors that sell sunglasses, retail jewelry, carded hair items, clothing with labels or flea market items will be accepted. If you are accepted and display any of the above items or ANY ITEM which is deemed inappropriate by the Bazaar committee, you will be **asked to leave and your fees will not be refunded**.
12. All sales at the Troop 853 Bazaar are limited to non-food type products. Concessions will be provided for purchase at the event.
13. Each Exhibitor must submit photographs of his or her craft(s) or item(s). See registration form for details.
14. Each Exhibitor will be expected to make a monetary donation or a donation of an item for the purposes of a drawing to be held the day of the Bazaar. All proceeds will benefit Troop 853.
15. Trash is the responsibility of each participant. The Bazaar committee will provide trash bags and a dumpster. Please ensure that your area is clean before leaving at the end of the day.
16. The Exhibitor will be fully responsible for any loss or damage to his or her property by theft, fire or casualty. Troop 853 expressly disclaims any responsibility for the same. Exhibitors shall be responsible for any damage which may be incurred to the facilities as a result of or in connection with its operation.
17. Application fees are not refundable. Troop 853 is not liable if weather or other conditions prevent the exhibitor from attending and fulfilling the contractual obligation as an Exhibitor. No refunds will be made for weather, accident, health or other causes for non-participation.
18. Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Troop 853 from and against any loss, expense, claims, damages, causes of action, injuries, suits or damages, suits to person or property, including attorney's fees, arising out of or related to the operation of the Exhibitors at Troop 853's Bazaar.
